SUPER KID CONTEST AWARD DAY IN MEDIA

Kochi: Six kids from LKG to Grade 4 categories from across the state have won gold medals at the T. Nettikadan Educators' annual super kid contest, prelim rounds of which were held in 300 centres across the state and participated by more than 35,000 kids from over 100 schools. The medals were distributed by P. M. Iris, standing committee chairman, Corporation of Thiruvananthapuram, on Saturday. T. P. M. Ibrahim Khan, president, CBSE Management Association felicitated.

MODE OF EXAMINATION

Individual test (Oral test) – LKG Written test – UKG to class IV

The examination consists of two parts: (Total marks -100)

Part A – 80 marks – 60% of the questions will be from the key book of the respective classes.

Part B – 20 marks for colouring. Use wax crayons only.

(Candidates should bring wax crayons for colouring)

FEES & MODE OF PAYMENT

Rs. 30 per student may be retained by the participating school for the expenses to conduct the exam & to transport the students to the nearest exam centre, if required.
